Challenge: Accessing Information in Atlantic Canada

From the major data providers:

- Federal Departments
 - e.g. Fisheries & Oceans, Environment Canada, Natural Resources Canada
- Provincial Departments
 - Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland & Labrador
- Other
 - Universities, private sector, NGO's
 - Etc.

COINAtlantic: Coastal and Ocean Information Network – Atlantic

An initiative of the ACZISC:

- A member driven programme
- Information managed by jurisdictions
- Timely access to information
 - i.e. not static as in an atlas
- Data/information is distributed
 - i.e. not centralized as in a data warehouse
- Builds on standards allowing integration from many sources

A Network of:


- People & agencies

COINAtlantic Example

- Province of Nova Scotia
 - Roads & Infrastructure
- Natural Resources
 Canada
 - National base map
 - Well bore holes
 - Multibeam image
- Fisheries and Oceans
 - bathymetry
 - -EEZ
 - SARA catch data
 - Coral Area



Challenge: Accessing Information in the Caribbean

From the major data providers:

- Member Nations of the Caribbean Sea Commission
- Key National Departments
 - e.g. fisheries, environment, natural resources
- Regional and International Organizations
 - e.g. CARICOM, OECS, FAO, UNDP, etc.
- Other
 - Universities, private sector, NGO's, etc.

Underlying Requirements for a COINCaribbean

- Develop and implement a framework for collaboration between and within CSC countries
- Make geospatial information publically available on the internet using established standards
- Ensure web accessibility

COINAtlantic/COINCaribbean: Collaborative opportunities

- Capacity building for CSC countries to implement a COINCaribbean
- Establishing network of data providers and users
- Training for information providers and users
- Engagement of CSC members in ongoing COIN research and development
